Presentations of the draft Vision Based Comprehensive Plan November and December 2018



The Canin Associates team will present a draft of the new vision based comprehensive plan later this year. The draft plan will incorporate the ideas generated during the Visioning workshops held in 2017 and the Vision adopted January 2018.

Three key areas of the City: **the Downtown**, the **Waterfront**, and our **Commercial Gateways** will be highlighted. In 2017, the workshop participants engaged in an interactive discussion to create scenarios for the future of each key area of the City, including downtown redevelopment opportunities, enhancements along the waterfront, and urban design strategies along our commercial gateways. The draft plan will consolidate these discussions into a document that addresses the Future Land Use Element, Transportation Element and Housing Element of the comprehensive plan.

The Community Development Department staff will give a presentation to the public on Thursday, **November 1st at 6pm**.


The presentation will be given to the Planning and Zoning Commission on Wednesday, **November 7th at 5pm**.

Resiliency Strategic Planning Workshop November 15th at 6:00 pm

Staff from the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council will lead an interactive workshop on flooding, impacts from sea-level rise and resiliency

From fall 2018 through the summer of 2019, the City of Titusville will be working with the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to better understand the potential shocks and stresses facing the City in planning for coastal resilience. The project will include a vulnerability assessment of local assets and infrastructure, development of a key set of strategies for improving resilience in future projects, and several opportunities for outreach and education.



Resilient Titusville is being funded by a grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) as the lead agency for the Florida Coastal Management Program, with funding from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).
