Brevard County Emergency Management, in cooperation with the National Weather Service in Melbourne, will be hosting the SKYWARN Basic and Advanced Spotter Training Class on Friday, December 11, 2015.

SKYWARN Training is geared towards anyone with an interest in public safety and communications during extreme weather events.

SKYWARN is a program developed and taught by National Weather Service (NWS) meteorologists and consists of trained weather spotters who report severe and hazardous weather to help in the weather warning process. SKYWARN Spotter reports provide vital "ground truth" to the NWS.

This advanced SKYWARN course focuses on hurricanes and strong to violent tornado events.

This is a FREE course, and each course section runs approximately 2 hours long. SKYWARN Basic Spotter Training will run from 10:00AM—12:00PM, followed by the SKYWARN Advanced Spotter Training from 1:00PM—3:00PM.
