What Do You Know About Your Drinking Water?

2017 Titusville Water Quality Report

TITUSVILLE, FL - (June 6, 2017) – If you have ever wondered about how your drinking water is treated or where it comes from, then you should check out a publication known as an annual water quality report. All community water systems, such as a city utility, are required to publish this report annually. The City of Titusville has just released its 2017 annual water quality report, *The Water We Drink*.

Each year, the City of Titusville Water Resources Department publishes an annual water quality report so that Titusville water consumers can learn about their drinking water and the services provided by their water utility. The report focuses on water quality monitoring from the previous calendar year, January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. Consumers who have any questions about the data presented in the report or about water quality should contact the Titusville Water Production Superintendent at (321) 567-3877.

Titusville invites its water consumers to take a few minutes and review the report. It is available online at titusville.com/ccr and on the Water Resources Department pages at www.titusville.com. “Consumers will be surprised about how much they can learn from viewing the report,” explained Maureen Phillips, Water Conservation and Public Outreach Manager. “In addition to the information required by state and federal regulations, we always include information on our water conservation program. This year’s conservation pages highlight outdoor water use with a list of thirteen tips homeowners can use to save water in their yard.”
