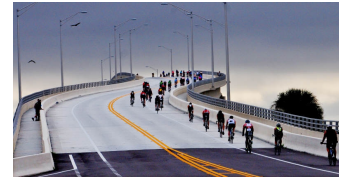

## Multimodal Transportation: Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning for the Future



*On June 27, 2018, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Greenways and Trails Council designated Titusville as a "Trail Town" due to the City becoming a hub of three converging multi-use trails: the Coast-to-Coast Trail, the St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop and the East Coast Greenway Trail.*

To build on these regional trail projects, the City hired Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. of Orlando, to help draft a multimodal transportation plan.

**What is a multimodal plan?** A multimodal plan considers various modes of travel (walking, cycling, automobile and public transit) and their connections between modes. The Titusville multimodal plan will focus on bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure with the purpose of connecting the City to the regional trail network.

## Public Information Meeting Monday, December 17, 2018 at 5:30pm



The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting to talk about a proposed multi-use trail that is part of the existing Coast to Coast trail and is intended to enhance pedestrian and bicyclist safety in the area, as well as complete the Titusville Gap. Additional roadway modifications and a median will be added on SR 406 to provide a refuge area for pedestrians at the proposed crosswalk. The purpose of this public meeting is to present and explain the proposed improvement, seek public and agencies' input, and provide interested persons an opportunity to provide feedback and comments to the design team.

The public meeting will be **Monday, December 17, 2018 at Titusville City Hall between 5:30-7:30 p.m.** The meeting will be conducted as an open house during which time displays and other project information will be available for review. Staff will also be available to discuss the project. An informational looping presentation will also be given playing throughout the open house. Participants may provide public comments at any time during the meeting. Written comments may also be submitted at this meeting. 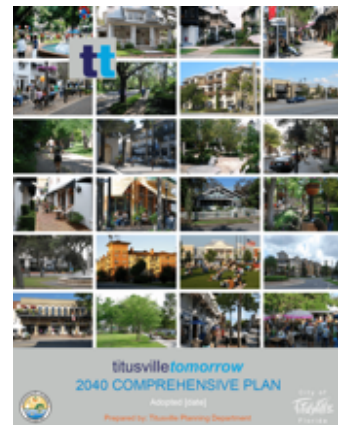

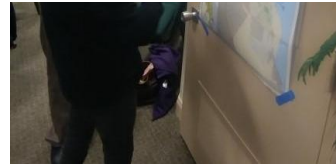


## ***from sea-level rise and resiliency this past November 15th***

The City of Titusville is working with the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to better understand the potential shocks and stresses facing the City in planning for coastal resilience. The project will include a vulnerability assessment of local assets and infrastructure; development of a key set of strategies for improving resilience in future projects; and several opportunities for outreach and education.

Resilient Titusville is being funded by a grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) as the lead agency for the Florida Coastal Management Program, with funding from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

## **State Road 406 (Garden Street) improvements**

***The FDOT will be milling, resurfacing and making bicycle and pedestrian improvements to portions of Garden Street and east of the Max Brewer Bridge***



The Florida Department of Transportation will be making roadway improvements to Garden Street, including construction of a 12-foot wide, multi-use trail and various pedestrian improvements that meet the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

The estimated completion of this project is Fall 2019.
