APOLLO DISTRICT INTERPRETIVE PROGRAMS May 2022

TUESDAY 10TH - 11:00 AM - “BROWN BAG LUNCH” Join us for a monthly discussion of interest to the community. Bring a lunch to share after the presentation. This month’s program will be presented by Felipe De Paula, the curator of the Ponce de Leon Inlet Lighthouse and Museum. Mr. De Paula will speak about the lifestyles and history of the Timucua and Mayaca people.

FRIDAY 13TH AND 27TH - 10:00 AM “CANOE MOSQUITO LAGOON” Reservations will be accepted a week before the canoe date. Join a guide as you explore this rich and diverse estuary up close. Some experience is preferred. You must be at least 8 years old and able to paddle. You must wear completely enclosed shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen, and a hat. Dress to get wet. There is a \$25 canoe rental fee. Call (386) 428-3384 ext. 0 to reserve your spot. Meet at the Pavilion behind the Visitor Center. (2 hours)

SUNDAY 15TH - “TURTLE WATCH RESERVATIONS” - 9:00 AM.

Starting Sunday, we will begin taking reservations for this year’s June Turtle Watch programs. The number to call is (386) 428-3384 ext. 248. The programs are open to all persons eight (8) years of age and older. Reservations have a maximum of six (6) persons per reservation call. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person ages 16 and above; 15 and under are free. Persons with an Access Pass or a Senior Pass receive a 50% discount for the card holder only. The programs will be presented in both Districts and run from 8:00 PM until midnight on June 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 16, 17, 18, 24, 25 and 30. Please have several dates in mind when you call and we ask that you keep your calls brief. Further information and instructions will be sent to you within two (2) weeks of your phone call. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors a unique opportunity to see a live sea turtle nesting.
