

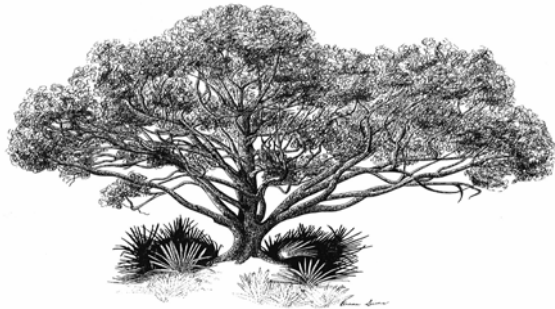
# Membership in the *Friends of the Enchanted Forest, Inc.*

### **EVENTS:**

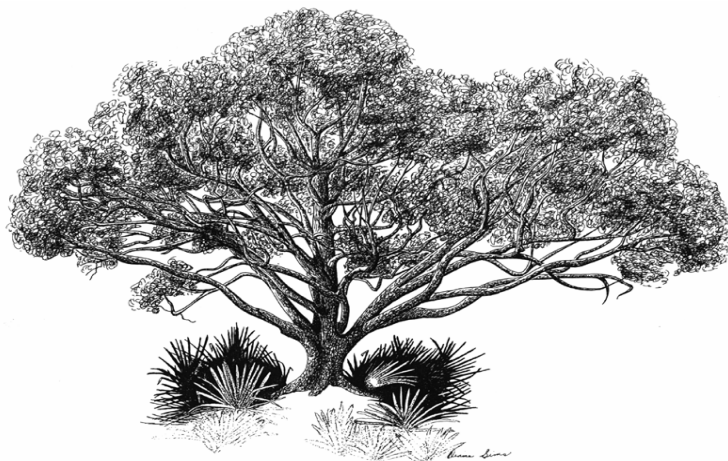
Earth Day, November Forest Fest, Forest Fundays, Friends Committee work and lead, meeting Programs,
