Join us as we provide information and understanding of Florida's Endangered Species!

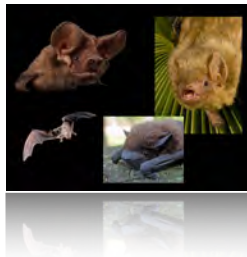
Speaker Presentations:

Sunday Morning Hike

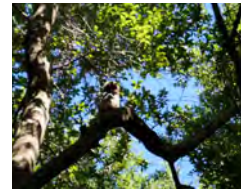
Sunday, May 7th, 10:00 am to 12:00 pm
