“Conserving Florida’s Natural Heritage from Scrub to Sea,” highlights our goal to protect Florida’s intricately linked coastal uplands, lowlands, and lagoon waters. Rare, high, coastal scrub connects through lowland marshes to the Indian River Lagoon System, an estuarine system more diverse in species than any other in the United States. Our little estuarine fish mascot, the goby, represents the aquatic links between freshwater draining from uplands and the salty waters of our coastal lagoons.
