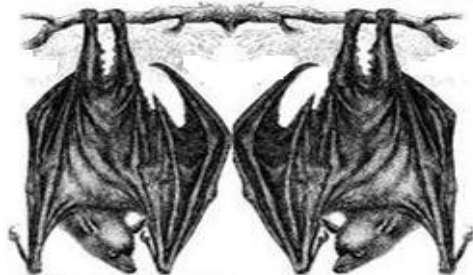

If you would be interested in any of this equipment, see Frances in the Business Office to have a "Look See" and make her an offer she can't refuse. All offers must be made by October 31.



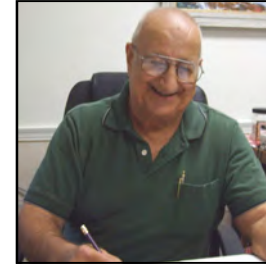
