EPIDEMIC OF BED BUGS IN AMERICA

Since much of our clothing, sheets, towels, etc. now come from companies outside of the US (including the high-end stores), it is recommended that when buying clothing, socks, underwear, sheets and towels etc., put them in your clothes dryer on hot for at least 20 minutes. The heat will kill them and their eggs. **DO NOT PURCHASE THESE ITEMS AND HANG THEM IN YOUR CLOSET FIRST.**

If you buy clothing from a thrift shop or yard sale, be sure it is washed in HOT water before wearing. One of our members, Kathy Parks, told me they were hit with bed bugs and it was a **nightmare getting rid of them.** Information will be located on the credenza in the lobby about these pests if you want further information.
