Thanksgiving Day, celebrated on the fourth Thursday in November, has officially been an annual tradition in the United States since 1863, when during the Civil War, President Lincoln proclaimed a national day of thanksgiving. The event that Americans commonly call the "First Thanksgiving" was celebrated to give thanks to Native Americans for helping the Pilgrims of Plymouth Colony survive their first brutal winter. The first Thanksgiving feast lasted three days, providing enough food for 53 pilgrims and 90 Native Americans.
