JANUARY HOT SOUP RECIPE



CORN SAUSAGE CHOWDER

Submitted by: Dotti Kunde

1/2 lb. Pork Sausage (like Jimmy Dean)
1/2 cup chopped onions
1 (10 3/4 oz.) condensed cream chix soup (with herbs, if possible)
1 3/4 cups milk
1 (14 3/4 oz) can golden cream style corn
1 (15 1/4 oz) can Fiesta corn with green and red peppers, drained.

Crumble sausage into medium saucepan, stir in onions. Cook over medium heat stirring often until sausage has browned; drain. Stir in soup, milk and corn. Cook, stirring until thick and bubbly.

Yield: 6 1/2 cups
