Ferrel Mazzatto – Nominee for President

I became a member of the NBSC in year 2000. I began teaching line dance classes in 2006, organized an annual fund raising event, The Space Coast Blast, raising over \$1000 that year and each year thereafter until the present. In 2007, I created our web site, (NorthBrevardSeniorCenter.Tripod.com), and in 2008 was elected to the board. Between 2009 and 2012, I was the activities coordinator, setting up the puzzle table, water fitness class, Wednesday afternoon and evening line dance classes, and teaching a class in line dance on Tuesday evenings. I have organized Mahjonn, Scrabble, Sewing Club, Gentle Yoga, Tai Chi, Country Couples, Mexican Train, Wii Bowling, Writers Club and various craft workshops. In 2009, I took on the duty of Special Events Chairman. In 2010 I started a monthly line dance party and D.J. that monthly event. In 2011, I was elected 1st Vice President and in 2012, I had the privilege of being elected President and currently hold that position. I have consistently and consciously carried out the duties of my position.

Dottie Kunde – Nominee for First Vice President

I do not remember the date that I joined the center, but starting volunteering around 2007, serving on the board, had a few years of serving as a Vice President, and I also served as Kitchen Manager and Cook, and catered all of the card parties, fashion shows, dinners, etc, whatever we had, I did it. In the last few years I have served on the board while cooking for special events that the center has hosted. I retired from my job at the Kennedy Space Center, after 24 years of cooking for the Astronauts. I went on to write and publish three cookbooks, two of the cookbooks contain “Astronaut” recipes and I have donated two of those books to the NBSC library for our members to enjoy and use. My other book is sold at a friend’s gift store in Connecticut. I love to play Bridge and that is what you would find me doing in my spare time. I also volunteer at the Mims United Methodist Church, Mullet Festival, Indian River Festival and the Martin Anderson Center. I have always fulfilled and will continue to take my board duties seriously.

Fred Phillips Nominee for Second Vice President

I graduated from Miami High School and attended the University of Miami for 2 years, studying Pre-Law. I then served in the Air Force and afterwards worked in electronics for 4 years. My main career was managing and eventually owning a company in construction equipment sales, repairs, and rentals for 40 years. My son still manages this company. I moved to Titusville in 2010 to be near another son and grandchildren and joined NBSC to enjoy dances. I was elected to the NBSC Board in 2011 and began chairing Saturday dances and am proud that attendance has been continually increasing. I am currently planning a new activity, Queen of Hearts, the purpose of which is to increase attendance and raise funds for the center. My current NBSC activities include dancing, Wii Bowling and cards and I am always available to help NBSC in any way possible.

John R. McLaughlin – Nominee for Treasurer

I joined the center in February of 2011 after which I volunteered for many temporary projects (table setup, facility repairs, bank deposits, financial data entry) etc. In May of 2011, I joined the bingo team where I still work the floor, call and act as cashier. In June of 2011, I was appointed Treasurer and subsequently was elected to the Treasury in December of 2011 and still hold the office. As treasurer we have revamped the revenue stream system and implemented audits to that system, resulting in an increase yield to activities. Also the accounting system has been modernized, resulting in improved reports and accountability. Prior to my retirement in 1997, I was employed by Usairways for 38 years both as a manager and then Director of Customer Services Systems and Procedures during my last 10 years of employment. My department had a staff of approximately fifty employees (managers, technical writers, training instructors etc).

Cat Simkins – Nominee for Secretary

I retired from NASA (Logistics Mgr) in Maryland and relocated to Titusville. Upon joining the Center over 9 years ago, I became active my first year assisting the 1st VP with special events and dances, calling on my 30+ years of experience holding events up north. As an experienced Bingo caller, I volunteered to call at NBSC and became a member of the Bingo Committee: I continue to participate in this activity every Thursday. After my first year, I was nominated for Board membership and subsequently appointed Special Events Chairman, a position I held until early 2010. I also began the Center's Bunco activity almost 4 years ago and I run it monthly. For about 2 years, I served as Newsletter Editor and Publicity Chairman. For over 5 years, I've run the Travel program, an active element of the Center for which NBSC is partnered with Martin Andersen Sr. Ctr. in Rockledge. I chaired the By-Laws Committee for revision of same and performed most of the work due to illness of the other committee members. In addition to the aforementioned, I have been serving as interim Special Events Chairman since this past spring.



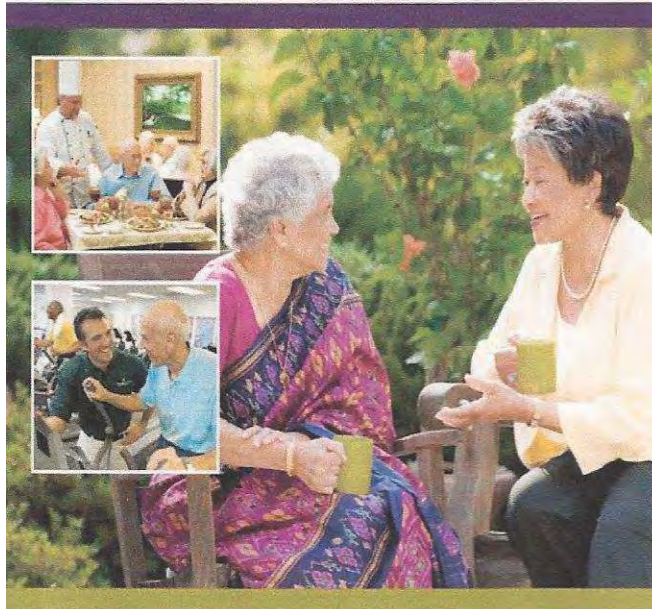
