The APD program can provide a Medicaid Waiver (Med Waiver) Support Coordinator (WSC) who can advise and coordinate the full range of services helpful to a person with special needs. The process by which someone gets access to a Waiver Support Coordinator (WSC) is as

- Waiver Support Coordinators are not allowed to solicit a caseload.
- A disabled person must first become a client of APD (Agency for Persons with Disabilities). They then have to request to be put on the iBudget Home and Community-Based Waiver.
- If accepted for the Waiver, they are then given a "Choice Letter" with WSC's that have openings (they have a legal limit of 43 full cases with minors being considered "half cases"). The individual and their family interviews available WSC's then selects the one
- Florida Medicaid Waiver Florida has several Medicaid waiver programs.


