The historic Pritchard House, an example of Queen Anne architecture, was built for Captain James Pritchard in 1891. The variety of materials used on the exterior, the jig saw decorative work, and elaborate use of shapes and textures produce a highly picturesque effect. Pritchard family descendents lived in the house until it was purchased by Brevard County in 2005. The North Brevard Heritage Foundation assisted the County in restoring the house and will oversee its operation as a house museum. The house was painted using historic colors. Gardens recognizing several of Titusville's founding families have been designed to accentuate the beauty of the house and provide charming spaces for gatherings and celebrations.
