All programs meet the requirements for the Canaveral National Seashore Junior Ranger Program.

**THURSDAY, 4<sup>TH</sup> & 18<sup>TH</sup> – 10:00 AM “MANATEE VIEWING”** – Observe manatee in their natural environment and learn about their unique characteristics from park staff. Meet at Eddy Creek. (1 hour)

**FRIDAY, 12<sup>TH</sup> & 26<sup>TH</sup> – 9:00 AM “WILDLIFE PHOTO WALK”** – Explore the seashore through the view finder. Discover the diversity and beauty of the various plants and animals within the seashore. Bring your camera, water, sunscreen and repellent. Meet at vista 3. (1 hour)

**FRIDAY, 19<sup>TH</sup> – 10:00 AM “PLAYALINDA BEACH CLEAN-UP”** – Join a ranger and help keep our shorelines trash free. Bring gloves, water and sunscreen. Trash bags provided. Meet at parking area #3. (1 hour)

**WEDNESDAY, 24<sup>TH</sup> – 10:00 AM “SHORELINE SEASHELL HUNT”** – Search for that seashell or sea bean with a ranger. Explore the beach wrack line for treasure. Bring water and sunscreen. Meet at parking area #1. (1 hour)

**THURSDAY, 25<sup>TH</sup> – 10:00 AM “PADDLE THE LAGOON”**- Some experience is required and be at least 10 years old and able to paddle and swim. Bring water, sunscreen, & sturdy water shoes. Dress to get wet. Reservations begin: one week in advance. **There is no charge for program, please bring your own kayak. We have limited number to reserve at \$25.** Call (321) 403-9334, to reserve a spot and kayak if needed (LIMITED KAYAK AVAILABILITY). Reserve a spot and meet at the Eddy Creek boat ramp. (2 hours)

**WEDNESDAY, 31<sup>ST</sup> – 10:00 AM “SEMINOLE REST WALK”** – Tour the grounds and explore the haunts from the past and present cultures. Meet at the parking lot. (1 hour)
