**“July Turtle Watch” –Most Thursday, Friday & Saturday evenings –8:00 PM – Midnight** - Journey with a National Park Ranger and visit the undisturbed beaches of Canaveral National Seashore to watch a loggerhead sea turtle nesting. Turtle Watch Programs give park visitors an opportunity to learn about sea turtles and the role that the National Park Service plays in their conservation. The program will take place at Playalinda Beach & Apollo Beach on most Thursdays, Fridays & Saturdays. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person, ages 16 and above. Ages 15 and under will be free. Children must be 8 years old or older to participate. **Reservation required and Space is limited.** To make a reservation, please call (386) 428-3384 Ext 0.

Enjoy a brief stroll along the accessible path that leads to the main house located on top of Snyder Mound. Explore the first floor of the late 1800's gothic revival style home located along Mosquito Lagoon in Oak Hill, Florida. (4 hours)
