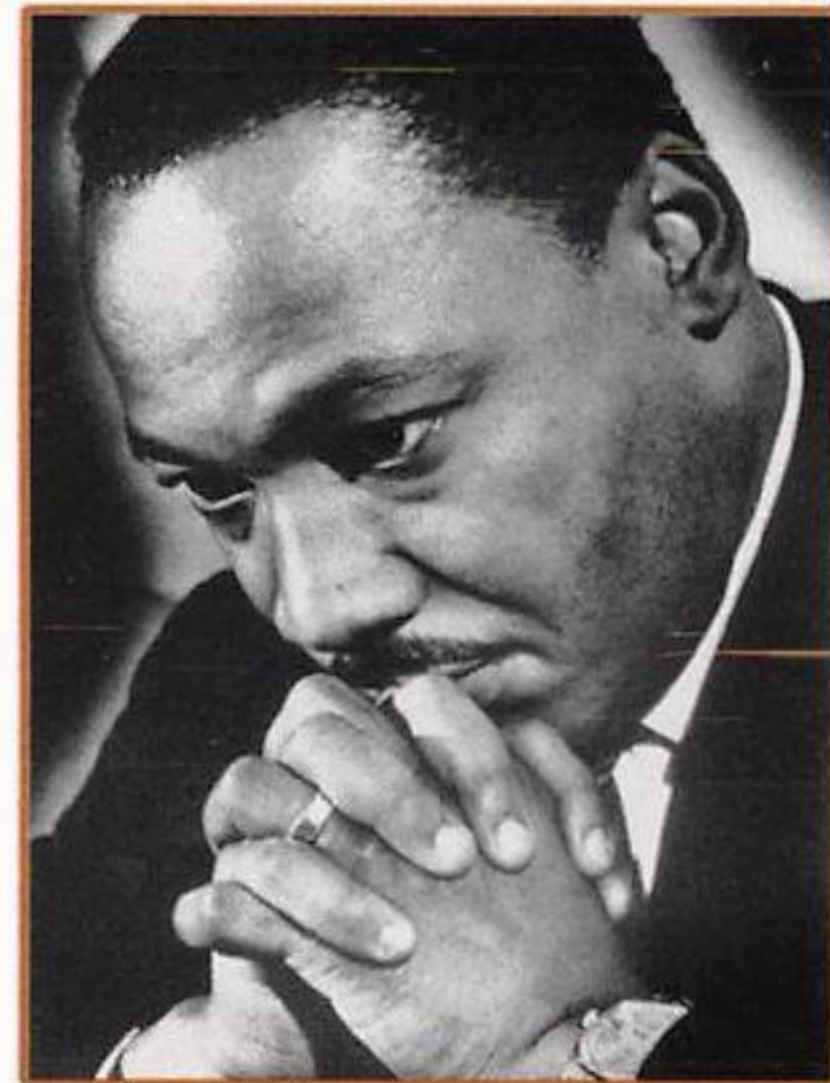
This year's theme is: "Building Bridges in the Community & Beyond".
