## Curriculum:

### **Grades VPK to 2: Little Pioneers**

Discover what life was like for Florida pioneers by visiting Brevard's oldest standing home (the 1875 Sams Cabin), doing pioneer "chores", and following the nature pathway that pioneer children hiked.

### **Grades 3 to 5: Florida's Diverse History**

Go back in time to Florida's origin and sift for fossils, explore Native American lifestyles, learn how to throw spears with an atlatl, experience life inside the 1875 cabin, and explore the surrounding habitats following trails and over land used by Megafauna, Native Americans, and pioneers.

### **Grades 6 to 12: Florida's Earth Ecology**

Learn about the soils, elevations, hydrology, and plant life that make Florida, and our Brevard County lands, unique. Hands on examination and field work strengthen concepts and engage students as we venture into the surrounding habitats.

### **Homeschool Programs: Alternative Study Trips**

Select from the Little Pioneers, Florida's Diverse History, Florida's Earth Ecology, Native American Workshop, Pollinators and Plants, Ice Age Megafauna, Origins Stories, Seed Dispersal, or others as developed Study Trips adapted for the homeschool environment.
