Below is Rosemary Pierce's winning artwork as an example.

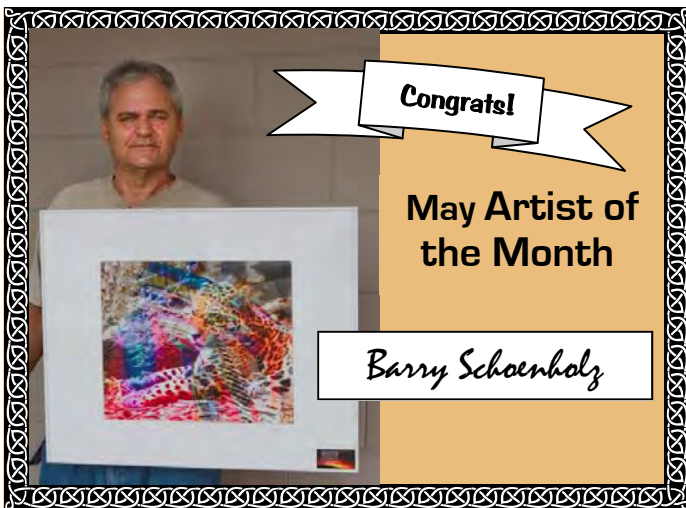
Due: At our October meeting, October 20th, 2010

Annual Sunshine Saturday



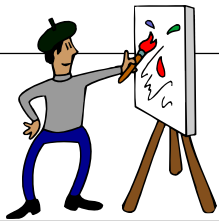
