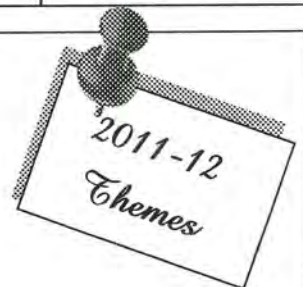

Rotating Community Exhibits: Pieces displayed at many public locations including government offices, doctor's offices, as well as private businesses.

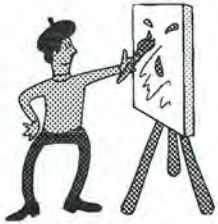
Art Show and Exhibits: Spring Art Show (Major cash award event) and member-only events.
