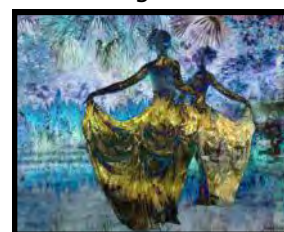
"How to Photograph Your Art" Guest Artist Jerry Hanzl



The **Digital Art** of Jerry Hanzl evolved out of his diverse backgrounds in computers and photography, along with commercial and fine art. He was educated at the *Cooper School of Art, Control Data Institute,* and the *Art Institute of Ft. Lauderdale.* Now, after many years of learning, Jerry tries to blend all of his skills into a medium that can only be understood as "**painting with photography on a digital canvas.**"

He first appeared on the local art scene in 2007 at a one-man show for the opening of his "Taylor Panels," a historical triptych. These panels are in the permanent collection at the Museum of History and Natural Science in Cocoa, Florida. By 2009, Jerry had created a collection of work which he featured in "**Truth or Dare**" - a two-artist show at the King Center for the Performing Arts in Melbourne. Later that year, he received national attention when **Art Business News** featured him as an "**Emerging Artist.**" To further showcase his digital creations, Jerry helped found the **Art Gallery of Viera** and is the **Creative Director** there.

Jerry is a surrealist at heart, in the spirit of Dali and Escher. His surreal-scapes are fantasy worlds meant to be travelled through with both the eyes and the mind.

It is with great sadness we acknowledge the passing of one of our most revered artists, **Rosemary Merrill Gordon**. She was born November 5, 1925 in Georgetown, Massachusetts and entered into rest on July 20, 2014.

The memorial service was held on Friday, August 15 at the North Brevard Funeral Home with Chaplain Donna Carey officiating. Many of her friends from the Titusville Art League attended what I think was one of the nicest, most fitting services I've ever attended. **Rosemary** herself had "scripted" the service, from the songs, poems, and scripture to the order in which they were presented. It almost felt as if **Rosemary** herself was among us displaying her artistic creativity and encouraging us to take full stock in ourselves and enjoy life, as it is the journey—not the destination—that fulfills us and makes us who we are. Thank you, **Rosemary**; we enjoyed our final journey with you at the memorial service. May you rest in peace.

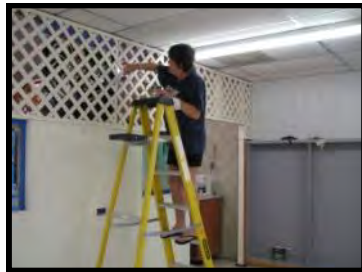

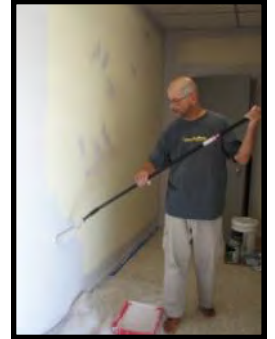
