



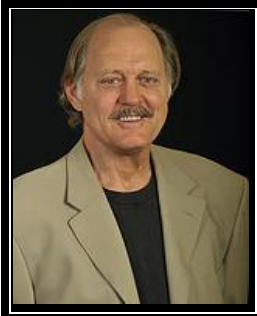

Dali was a real departure for me as I currently (mostly) work on animal portraits in watercolor.
