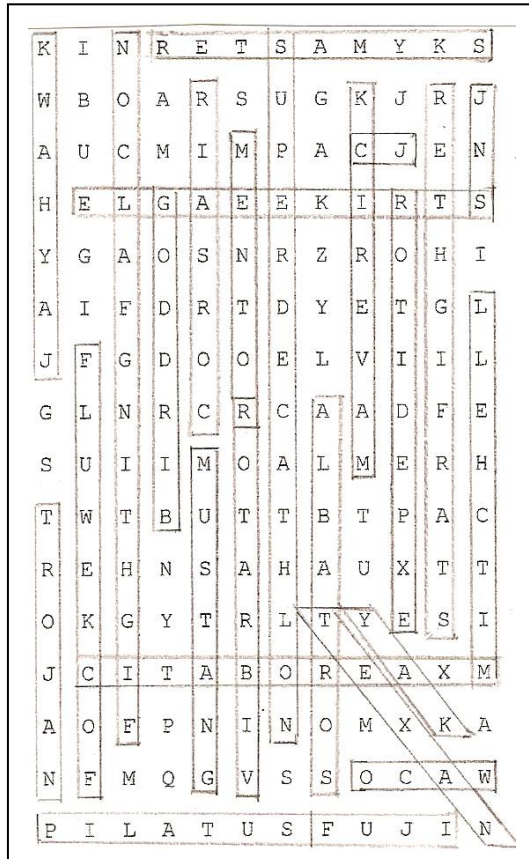
From a Member's Kitchen

Frannie's Pseudo Coco-Nut Cookies

1/4. cup (1 stick) butter or margarine
1 cup sugar
1 teaspoon coconut extract
1 small egg
1 . cup (full measuring cup) Bisquick
1 . cup spud flakes or potato flakes
(Do not use instant mashed potatoes)

Cream together butter, sugar and coconut extract, add egg, and beat until well blended. Stir in Bisquick and spud flakes. Cover bowl and chill about 1 hour or overnight. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Shape dough into marble size balls and place 2 inches apart on ungreased baking sheet. I use pan liners to prevent sticking). Bake 12 to 14 minutes. Makes about 4 dozen cookies.

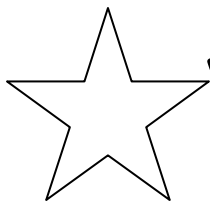
